You'll learn the holistic applications of IT and how to implement them in the real world today. The course covers the technical areas of computer systems and networking and the practical applications of app development and Coding.

For this project, you will:

- Research (in-depth) one digital technology that changed the world.
- Analyse how businesses utilise social media.
- Analyse the basic principles of website design.

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Task 1:

Create a presentation that analyses one piece of digital technology and explains how it changed the world.

- a) **Origin** - How the technology was created (*Who, where, why etc.*).
- b) **Size** - How many people use this technology today?
- c) **Jobs** - List 10 different job roles that directly uses this technology everyday
- d) **Detail** - Obtain information about how the technology has evolved:
 - a. What was the initial role of the technology?
 - b. What is the current use for the technology?
 - c. How has the price of the technology changed over the years?
 - d. How can the technology be developed or improved?

Task 2:

You are a Digital Entrepreneur planning to develop a Mobile App. In order to gain government funding to set up your business you must demonstrate that you understand how to use Social Media for your Business and that you understand target audiences to engage with.

Focus on the following social media platforms:

- LinkedIn
- Instagram
- Twitter
- Facebook

Create a written presentation, in which you provide an analysis of the different ways in which a business can use social media. You should cover how social media is used by real Companies to interact with their customers and promote their business products and/or services.

Use screenshots of posts and interactions to help with your explanation and analysis.
