One of the major aspects of your assignment work whilst studying Creative Arts ability to engage and communicate with an audience.

For this summer task, investigate different ways to present information to an audience, in one of the following formats:

- A monologue
- A song or musical piece,
- A video – report, dramatic scene or indie film style sequence,
- A presentation,
- A piece of art work in a medium of your choice (it must be easy to move, so not too big or heavy)
- A photography reportage story
- An animation.

Over the summer create a piece of work, in the format of your choice, that best reflects something about you. It could be a personality trait, a hobby or interest, an ambition, or just something you enjoy doing.

You will share what you have created with your tutor on the first day, and you will present your work to your peer group and tutor during the first week.

Duration of your summer task

- Performance pieces should be no more than 1 minute
- Video sequences should be no more than 1minute 30 seconds
- Presentations should be no more than 1 minute 30 seconds
- Art work should be one or two pieces of manageable size
- Photo reportage should be no more than 5 images
- Animation should be no more than 1 minute.
